Progress Report re Lightning Incident in Sipalay City, Negros Occidental (Region VI)

A. Situation Overview

- At around 1:15 PM, 18 April 2018, a lightning incident transpired at Sitio Barasbarasan Brgy. Manlucahoc, Sipalay City, Negros Occidental.

B. Effects

- 6 persons were reported dead and 17 persons were injured due to the incident, to wit:

C. Actions Taken

- Sipalay Emergency Assistance and Rescue Services (SEARS) personnel responded to the incident.
 - Sipalay City DRRM Office and 15IB Charlie Company immediately brought the victims to Sipalay City Health Office for medical treatment.
 - Concerned agencies conducted post assessment and provided psychosocial support to the patients and families of the victims.
 - CDRRMO Sipalay City referred the families of the victims to concerned offices for medical, burial and financial assistance.
 - OCD VI coordinated with CDRRMO Sipalay on the development of the incident.
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
