I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"KARDING" CONTINUES TO MOVE GENERALLY NORTHWARD WHILE MAINTAINING ITS STRENGTH.

"KARDING" will not make landfall in any part of the country and is expected to exit PAR **tomorrow (11 August)**.

Meanwhile, at 10:00 PM today, the **Tropical Depression was estimated at 1,065 km West of Extreme Northern Luzon (OUTSIDE PAR) (20.0°N, 111.8°E) with maximum winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 75 km/h. It is moving North, slowly.**

This **Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) enhanced by both Tropical Storm KARDING and the Tropical Depression outside the PAR will bring scattered to widespread moderate to heavy rains over Batanes, Babuyan Group of Islands, Ilocos Region, Cordillera Administrative Region and the western section of Central Luzon beginning today.** Residents of these areas, especially those living near river channels, in low – lying areas and in mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate actions against possible flooding and landslides, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates. **Meanwhile, the Southwest Monsoon will also bring scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Metro Manila, Mindoro Provinces, CALABARZON, and the rest of Cagayan Valley and Central Luzon.**

Sea travel remains risky over the western seaboard of Luzon.

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "KARDING" was estimated based on all available data at 1,075 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (23.3°N, 131.9°E).
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Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 75 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 90 km/h
Forecast Movement:	Moving North, Slowly.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 08** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
